

Information and consent form for participation in videos and digital stories

When using film and digital storytelling as educational tools, consent must be obtained from all parties involved in the individual stories, unless the recording is solely of the lecturer or the lecturer's voice. If consent is not obtained, or if one person does not consent to audio and/or visual footage being taken, changes must be made to the planned work and these need to be approved by all parties before the recording can go ahead. The changes need to protect the interests of parties who did not consent to the recording of the digital story.

Videos and digital stories are not universally accessible, but are stored securely for as long as they are academically relevant or as long as storage is for historical, statistical or scientific purposes.

- VID will not release digital audio/images without express consent from the students.
- VID will not take photos of students when they are very lightly dressed.
- Photos published online will always be of a quality that makes it undesirable for other parties to manipulate them or use them in other contexts.
- VID will always request students' express consent prior to taking photos of them for
 journalistic purposes, or if students in work experience placements wish to take photos
 of other students.
- In the event that consent is withdrawn, published photos and videos must be deleted.
- Only active consent can provide the basis for publishing photos and videos.

Students may withdraw consent without specifying a reason. The relevant faculty or centre must be notified of the withdrawal of consent in writing. [e-post fyll ut når tilpasse]

The consent form must be signed for each coursework requirement.

Consent form for publishing recordings stored in a secure, encrypted area I agree to participate in videos and digital stories involving audio recordings and photos/videos of students in the learning situation at VID. The digital stories will not be universally accessible, and will be stored in a secure, encrypted area on VID's intranet for as long as they are academically relevant.
